You all did a terrific job on Saturday, exceeding the total species of last year's Count (2011: 37 species, 2163 birds).

<u>Highlights</u>: Mary Jewett (new to our Count this year) & Patty Schorr found ring-necked ducks at the north end of Long Lake, and Bohemian waxwings; Nancy Capone & Melanie Ring watched a sharp-shinned hawk nab a tree sparrow and proceed to eat it (they also saw the shrike on McNeil Rd, Fryeburg, and snow buntings); Kathy Banks found golden-crowned kinglets; Brian Cushing & Dave Steeves found cedar waxwings; Sue & Sam Black found pine grosbeaks; the song sparrow appeared on our porch after I had given up for the day. Loraine Janelle (new to our Count this year) saw an adult bald eagle fly over her house – within the Circle - during Count Week (CW).

<u>Feeder Highlights</u>: Ten feeder counters participated this year, adding 309 birds, and 2 species to the Count! Linda Hatch saw a white-throated sparrow; Melissa Norton & Julie Harmon saw (and documented) 2 female evening grosbeaks. Individual feeder counters sometimes think they don't add much, but together they make a significant contribution.
